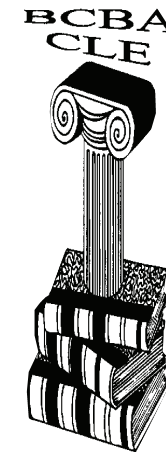
Note: Attorneys requesting Pennsylvania CLE credit must submit an additional \$15.00 fee for processing.

In New York State, new attorneys admitted to practice after October 1, 1997 must complete 32 credit hours of Mandatory Continuing Legal Education during their first 2 years after admission. Of the 32 hours, 6 must be in ethics, 12 in skills, and 14 in various areas of professional practice. All other attorneys must complete 24 hours of accredited Continuing Legal Education each biennial registration period, 4 hours of which must be in ethics and professionalism. Our Speakers

HON. ROBERT S. ROSE - Justice Rose graduated from Chenango Valley High School, St. Lawrence University and Albany Law School. He then served in the United States Army as a Captain in West Germany and South Viet Nam. Upon returning to Broome County, he served as confidential law clerk to New York State Supreme Court Justice Robert E. Fischer and then as an Assistant Broome County District Attorney. He practiced with the firm of Twin-ing, Nemias, Hill & Steflik until January 1988, when he was elected to the Supreme Court. In 1998 he was appointed by Chief Judge Judith Kaye as the Administrative Judge for the Sixth Judicial District, and in 2000 he was appointed by Governor George Pataki to the Appellate Division, Third Department. In 2002 he was reelected to a second term as a Supreme Court Justice and reappointed to the Appellate Division. Upon reaching mandatory retirement age of 70 in 2013, he was "certificated" by the Chief Administrative Judge for an additional two-year term as a Supreme Court Justice and reappointed to the Appellate Division by Governor Andrew Cuomo.

CYNTHIA FEATHERS ESQ. is a solo practitioner, drawing upon 25+ years experience in appeals, concentrating her practice in civil and criminal appeals in state and federal court and provides legal research, analysis, and writing services. She has handled over 400 appeals on behalf of numerous law firms, trial attorneys and organizations. She was Director of Pro Bono Affairs for the New York State Bar Association (2002-2007) coordinating the State Bar's "access to justice" statewide initiatives - winning reversals in major pro bono appeals. As an Assistant Attorney General, (1990-1993) she has handled appeals on behalf of the state in all Appellate Divisions, the Court of Appeals, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit, and the U.S. Supreme Court. Ms. Feathers received a B.S.J. magna cum laude from Northwestern University (1976) and J.D. with honors from Boston College Law School (1987).
